1. Second Chance Camp :

Dristi Foundation, has organized the Four Months Scheduled Second Chance Camp from 11th April 2014 to 10th August 2014 at Puranigudam, Nagaon Assam.

Second Chance Camps provide second chance to adolescents, have an important role in the education and development of adolescents. There are a number of age specific physical, psychological and emotional needs, which require effective dealing. General tendency in schools, families and in larger society is to ignore them. Working on the issues of adolescents' concerns in a collective mode. A participants group of 50 people from different part Nagaon joined The Camp. The Program was sponsored by the **Ministry of Youth affairs and Sports**.

2. CIRC(Community Information Resource Center)

Rural Digital Literacy Program :

Under its community information Resource Center we provide rural people the facility of internet browsing and all other internet services and also free computer training to rural students. Under this program this year we provided free computer training to 20(twenty) rural economically backward students. This year we organized this training from 2nd April to 30th August 2014. The course is designed as the Professional course of DTP(Desktop Publication) of 4(Four) Months which includes Networking and Internet Browsing.

3. Vocational Training Program :

- i) Under its Vocational Training Program a training on **Food Processing and Preservation** was organized this year. This training was organized for the beneficiaries of SHGs. 50 woman from 10 (ten) different SHG group participated in the program.
- ii) A training on **Cutting & Tailoring** was also organized. Course duration was for one month and number of participants were 20nos.
- iii) The no of participants in the **Tercotta designable products** were 25nos.
- iv) This year under Vocational Training Program a Training on **Jute Products** were organized for 15days with 30 nos of participants.

4. Aryabhata Science Center Activities:

Aryabhata Science Center is effortlessly working for the promotion of general science amongst the students of its Block area. Like previous years this year also Aryabhata Science Center organized various programs and lead the students in different School level activities in District and Block Level. In another program sponsored by ASTEC Under its Aryabhata Science Center, Dristi Foundation distributed free solar lamps amongst meritorious students of High schools studying in class IX, which list was collected in 2011.

5. Nai Roshni, Leadership Development Training for Minority Woman:

The status of women in the country, particularly those from the disadvantaged sections of the society, is unfavorable. A girl child suffers from discrimination even before birth

and also after birth in the allocation of household resources such as food, education, access to health care and at puberty, sometimes coerced into early marriage. Most women in the rural areas suffer from double burden of carrying out less quantifiable work like cooking, fetching water, sending children to school along with agriculture labour, feeding cattle, milking cows etc., while the men folk perform defined activities like selling milk and grains produced by the household. Women in the minority communities fare badly too. They are not just a minority, but the 'marginalized majority' and are sidelined in decision making in the family, and usually cut off from full involvement in the workings of the community and form an equal share in the rewards from social institutions.

Keeping this in mind ministry of minority affairs has started the project named Nai Roshni, designed a training program for the leadership development of minority woman. Under this program we have organized nine camps in Three different Panchayats of Barhampur Development Block.
